On September 17, 2015 a Deputy from the Bates County Sheriff's Office was asked to assist the CNET Drug Task Force on a drug investigation. The Deputy conducted a vehicle stop on a vehicle inside the city limits of Adrian. The driver of the vehicle, identified as Bodie Woods (DOB 12/25/1983), acted very nervous when the Deputy asked him to step out of the vehicle. Woods was very hesitant and started to reach towards the center console. The Deputy was unsure of what Woods was attempting to reach for so the Deputy removed Woods from the vehicle. Woods was placed into handcuffs while the Deputy continued his investigation. A passenger in the vehicle, identified as Nickolas Plumb (DOB 9/15/1990), was also asked to step out of the vehicle. Woods gave the Deputy consent to search the vehicle. During his search of the vehicle, the Deputy located digital scales that had a large amount of a white substance on it that field tested positive for methamphetamine. The Deputy also located a glass pipe as well as a cigarette pack that had a green leafy substance in it. The substance field tested positive for marijuana.

Both subjects were transferred to the Bates County Jail.



Bodie Woods was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana. He was also charged with Unlawful use of Drug Paraphernalia. His bond was set at \$12500.00 cash or surety.



Nickolas Plumb was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance Except 35 grams or less of Marijuana and also for Unlawful use of Drug Paraphernalia. His bond was also set at \$12500.00 cash or surety.
