During the evening hours of 5/3/16 a Deputy was in the area of Passaic when he observed a subject driving a 80's model Chevy S-10 pickup who was known to him as having multiple felony warrants out of Bates County. The Deputy attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The subject failed to yield and continued at a high rate of speed. The Deputy pursued the vehicle to Drexel where he lost sight of it. The pursuit was terminated in Drexel, MO.

Around 11:00 a.m. today a Sgt. was patrolling in Drexel, MO. He observed the same vehicle that failed to yield to the Deputy last night. The Sgt. tried to initiate a traffic stop on the pickup. The subject drove the pickup off the road and fled from the scene on foot. The subject, identified as David Miller, is still on foot at this time. His Chevy S-10 pickup that he was driving was towed from the scene.

Due to the nature of Miller's willingness to put Citizens and Law Enforcement in harm's way, Sheriff Anderson is offering a \$250.00 reward for any information that will lead to David Miller's arrest.
